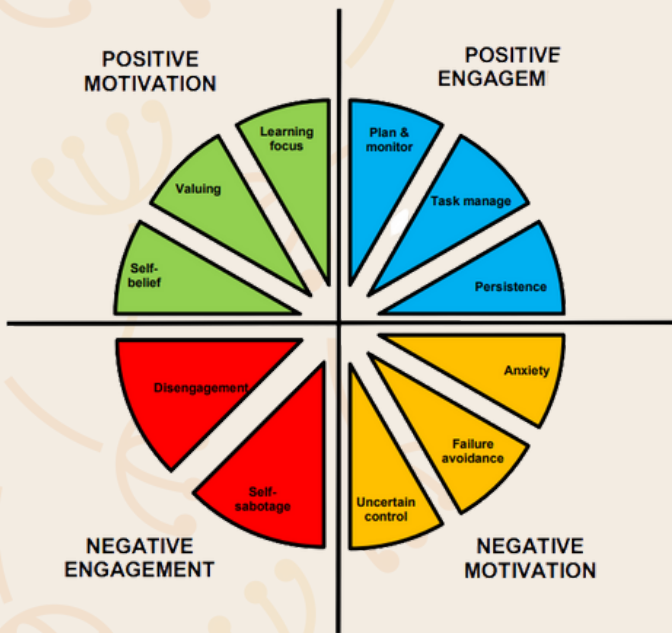

BOOSTING STUDENTS' LEARNING MOTIVATION AND ENGAGEMENT

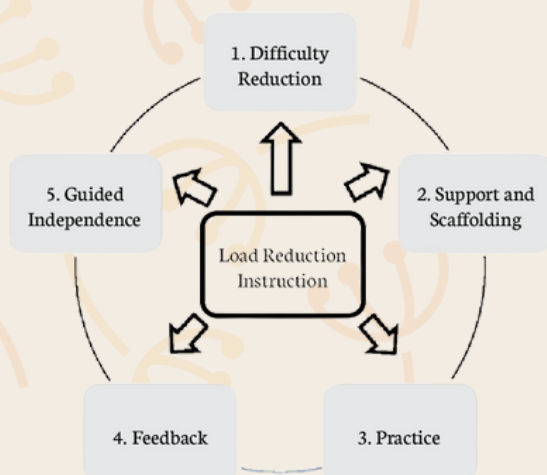
Teachers hold the key to students' motivation and engagement. There are practical ways for educators to spark and sustain students' motivation and engagement for the optimal learning outcome!

2. APPLYING INSTRUCTIONAL STRATEGIES

Apply the five principles of **Load Reduction Instruction (LRI)** to get the optimal balance between explicit instruction and constructivist teaching.



1. KNOWING AND TARGETING THE KEY PARTS OF MOTIVATION AND ENGAGEMENT

Identify where your students sit on each part of the **Motivation and Engagement Wheel**, increase the positive motivation and engagement factors and reduce the negative ones.

3. BUILDING GOOD TEACHER-STUDENT RELATIONSHIPS

Use **Connective Instruction** as a practical means to embed quality relationships into the everyday course of pedagogy. There are three key relationships (the Who, What and How) to cultivate in Connective Instruction:
